Job Qualifications: Candidate must be licensed to practice law in Colorado, or clearly eligible to waive into the Colorado Bar, be in good standing and have a minimum of five years of Colorado workers' compensation litigation experience. Specifically, candidates must have expertise in the Workers' Compensation Act and its procedure, including appellate procedure. Preferred qualifications include experience advising employers, the ability to work both independently and productively as part of a team, familiarity with state-wide workers' compensation judges, and an understanding of the State Personnel System and its rules. The successful candidate will have excellent skills in all aspects of litigation, legal writing, and oral communication.

All final candidates for employment must successfully pass a thorough criminal background investigation.
